The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 73.2 in the identified area, compared to 72.1 for the U.S. as a whole.

The number of families in the current year is 100,753 in the specified area.

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Current median household income is \$79,951 in the area, compared to \$72,603 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$90,834 in five years, compared to \$82,410 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$108,346 in this area, compared to \$107,008 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$124,711 in five years, compared to \$122,048 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$40,617 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$41,310. The per capita income is projected to be \$46,985 in five years, compared to \$47,525 for all U.S. households

Currently, 60.5% of the 162,837 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 33.7%, renter occupied; and 5.9% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.5% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.7% are renter occupied; and 9.8% are vacant. In 2020, there were 151,373 housing units in the area and 5.9% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 2.27%. Median home value in the area is \$307,280, compared to a median home value of \$308,943 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.61% annually to \$349,482.

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
